December Book Report Quilt

Genre: Fairy Tale, Legend, Myth Due: December 20, 2019

<u>Description</u>: A quilt is made from several pieces of material that are sewn together in an interesting design. Quilts come in many different designs. For this project, you will be making your own quilt design and then filling the spaces with information about the book you read.

Materials:

- · Quilt pattern block provided by Mrs. Hausdorf (attached)
- · Colored pencils, crayons, or markers (to outline)
- · Scissors
- 9×12 Construction paper
- . Ruler and glue

<u>Directions</u>: 1. Read a fairy tale, legend, or myth of your choice. As you read, take notes about the main character and your feelings about the book in general.

- 2. On the quilt pattern, plan a design for your quilt block that will give you at least four spaces in which to write and draw. Divide the block into sections.
- 3. In one space, write the title of your book. In one space, describe the main character(s). In one space, write your reaction to the book (how the book made you feel/how you feel about the book's message). In one space draw a picture or describe your favorite part of the book. In any remaining spaces, create a design.
- 4. Trace over all of your writing with a Sharpie marker.
- 5. Color your guilt spaces to create the design pattern.
- 6. Using your glue stick, mount the finished quilt block onto construction paper, leaving a colored border around the outside edges.

Criteria for Grading:

- · Is the guilt square neat, colorful, and attractive?
- · Does it contain your own thoughts?
- · Does it tell about the book, including how it made you feel?
- . Did you draw a picture or describe your favorite part of the book?
- · Is it well constructed?
