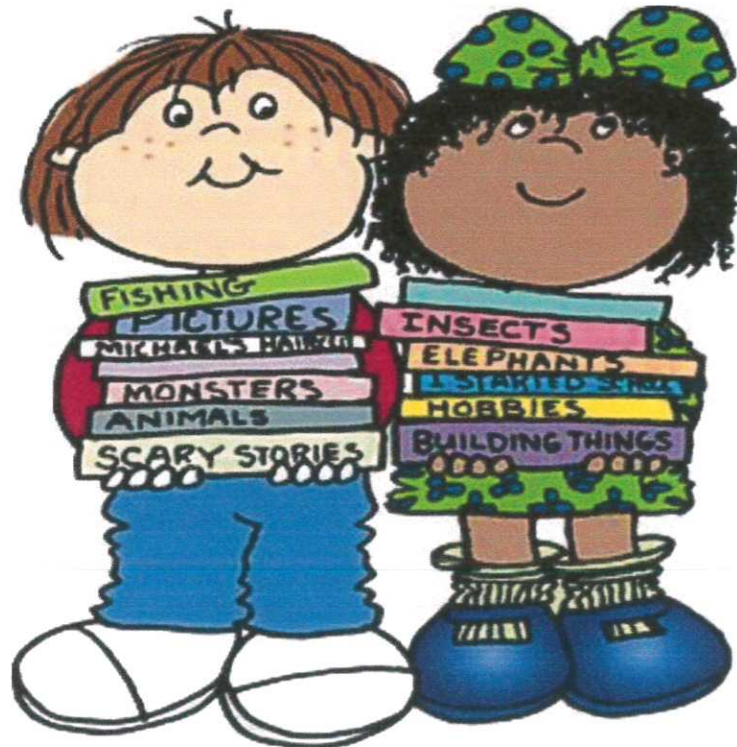


January Book Report
